Subject: Mock Exam for the applicants for Coach Education Programme(CEP)- Exams of Sports Authority of India(SAI).

CEP exams (on sports science and specified sports disciplines) of SAI are scheduled on 13-14th June 2020.

With a view to familiarise the applicants with the requirements of the internet based examination process, it is hereby informed that a mock exam for all the applicants of the CEP exams of SAI has been scheduled as follows:

Mock exam will be held on 11th and 12th June 2020 in two sessions each day as follows:

- 11.00 AM to 1.00 PM
- 3.00 PM to 5.00 PM

Candidates can take the mock exam during the time period(s) mentioned above, in the specific mode opted by them in their exam application form, i.e. laptop or Personal computers or mobile phones.

An invitation e-mail will be sent to all the candidates who had successfully submitted their application form (whether for sports science or specific sports discipline), from saiaexam@nta.ac.in guiding them on the process.

Mock exam will be held only in Sports Science for all candidates including those who had applied only for specific discipline. No mock exam will be held separately on specific sports disciplines since the objective of the exercise is to put the candidates at ease on the test delivery platform and subject specific content is not relevant for the purpose.

Detailed instructions for those who have opted to take the exam on personal computer or laptop are enclosed. (Annexure I).

Detailed instructions for those who have opted to take the exam on mobile phones are enclosed. (Annexure II).

Candidates are advised to read the instructions carefully before taking the test.

Instructions to candidates-Mock and Actual Exam (For those who take the exam on laptops and PCs

A mock exam is scheduled on the 11-12th of June 2020, SI Examination. The intent of this Mock Exam is to provide you with a session to experience the online platform in a better manner and check all the system requirements for the platform. This will help you to solve any of the concerns/issues before the main assessment scheduled on the 13-14th of June 2020. The guidelines/instructions for the assessments are mentioned below and are to be adhered to.

1. An invitation email will be sent by NTA (from saieexam@nta.ac.in) on the registered email address of all the candidates who had submitted their forms successfully. Candidates are requested to check their inbox/spam/junk folder to locate the invitation email.
2. Candidates will also receive a guide with all the details regarding the Software and Hardware requirement of the computer system. Please ensure compliance before the examination
3. Candidates are requested to check the System's Compatibility in advance through the button provided in the invitation email.
4. Candidates are required to start the test using the Start Test button provided in the invitation email as per the schedule.
5. We recommend using the latest version of Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox for a seamless experience.
6. Before starting the test, please close all chat windows, screensaver, etc.
7. Ensure that you have a stable internet connection for uninterrupted test experience.
8. Do not press "F5" during the test at any time, as doing so will cause your test to finish abruptly.
9. On the registration page, you will be required to enter your correct application number to start the test.
10. You must keep a valid photo ID proof (attached during registration) handy before you start the test and during the test for the authorization process.
11. For the authorization process, you must follow the steps given below:
 - a) First, you have to capture a snapshot of your own self. Kindly ensure that the snapshot is clearly visible.
 - b) Secondly, you have to capture the snapshot of a valid ID proof in such a way that the name and the photo on the ID card are clearly visible.
 - c) In case the details submitted are not clear you would be asked to resubmit the details until the proctor receives the clear details.
 - d) We request you to be patient and cooperative as this is an extremely important process.
12. You will not be permitted to use mobile phones or any other electronic devices during the test.
13. You will not be allowed to move away from your seat during the test.
14. You will not be allowed to take any restroom breaks during the assessment.
15. You are not allowed to lip-sync or read the questions aloud.

16. You should not refer to any books or reference materials or notes. Such an act would be treated as an act of unfair means and would lead to disqualification from the examination.
17. Any attempt to use/search answers from google or any other online site would lead to disqualification from the examination.
18. You will not be allowed to have food/beverage during the exam except water.
19. There should be sufficient light in the room, you choose to take the test from.
20. Please ensure you are the only person in the room during the test and there is no disturbance.
21. At any point of time during the test, if the Proctor finds any suspicious eye movements or any suspicious activities in the test environment, you can be asked by the proctor through Chat, to turn your Laptop/Webcam to show your surroundings to maintain the sanctity of the examination.
22. Warning on chat shall appear on the candidate's console on suspicious behavior. After repeated warnings from the Proctor, the Test shall be called off.
23. Keep a check on the chat window for any communication from the Proctor.
24. Candidates are not permitted to wear headphones
