Other sections are common for all.</p> <p>Medium of the paper: Question paper will be bilingual -in both Hindi and English except the Section on Language and Communication which will be in English only.</p>

Post test matters	<p>- NTA will display Provisional Answer Keys &amp; recorded responses of each candidate (accessible through unique enrolment no) on the website <a href="https://atdsc.nta.nic.in">https://atdsc.nta.nic.in</a> on a date communicated through students through NTA website and <b>public notice/press release in advance.</b></p>		



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The candidates, who are not satisfied with the answer key, may challenge by filling an online application form ONLY and paying a non refundable sum of Rs.200/-per question, in the given window.</li><li>- Experts examine the challenges received, and if needed key is revised.</li><li>- The result will be compiled on the basis of final answer keys.</li><li>- No grievance with regard to answer key(s) after declaration of result will be entertained. NTA's decision on the challenges shall be final and no further communication will be entertained.</li></ul>
Evaluation Methodology	<p>Responses of candidates will be processed by the system as per the answers keys finalised.</p> <p>If any anomaly or discrepancy is found during key verification, NTA shall address them in the following manner:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- If more than one option are found to be correct post challenge or during key verification - Marks would be awarded to those students who have marked any of the correct options.</li><li>- If all options are found to be correct – Marks would be awarded to all students, who have attempted the question</li><li>- If none of the options is correct/question is found to be wrong – all students who appeared in the test would be awarded full marks.</li></ul>
Results	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Results will be processed and handed over to National Institute of Sports for further action at their end.</li></ul>
Re-checking of answers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- There is no provision for re-checking of answers.</li></ul>
