Release of Admit Cards for National Council of Hotel Management Joint Entrance Examination (NCHMJEE) -2021

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will be conducting the National Council of Hotel Management Joint Entrance Examination (NCHMJEE) for admission to the B.Sc. (Hospitality & Hotel Administration) Programme offered by National Council of Hotel Management and Catering Technology (NCHM&CT) at its affiliated Institutes for the academic year 2021-22 on **10th August 2021 (Tuesday)** in the online mode (**Internet based mode**).

Admit cards of candidates for appearing in the exam, are now hosted on <https://nchmjee.nta.nic.in>.

Candidates can download their Admit Cards from the said website using their Application Form Number and Date of Birth and read the instructions contained therein carefully.

Candidates are advised to note the following:

- The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility conditions.
- Admit Card will not be sent by post.
- Candidate must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of the admission process.
- Candidates are advised to preserve a copy of their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
