The National Testing Agency (NTA) is conducting the JEE(Main) April, 2019 Examination on 7th ,8th, 9th , 10th, and 12th April, 2019 for 9,58,618 registered candidates (9,35,741 for Paper-I & 1,69,767 for Paper- II). 22, 8 9 4 Candidates are registered for the examination at 16 centres in 13 cities in North Eastern States and 9,881 Candidates at 12 centres in 4 cities in Jammu & Kashmir.

The JEE (Main) 2019 Examination will be conducted on Computer Based Test (CBT) as per following details:-

- (a) Paper-1 (B.E. /B. Tech.) in “Computer Based Test (CBT)” mode only.
- (b) Paper-2 (B. Arch/B.Planning): Mathematics-(Part I) and Aptitude Test-(Part II) in “Computer Based Test (CBT)” mode and Drawing Test –(Part III) in “Pen & Paper” (offline) mode.

The Examination would be conducted in 470 Centres in 267 Cities (09 outside India).

The Paper-II of the Examination is being held tomorrow on 7th April, 2019 in 02 shifts. About 169,795 candidates are appearing this Test at 370 centres (inclusive of 08 centres abroad).

All the preparations for the exam have been completed:

- a) A Control Room has been opened and 30 State Coordinators, 263 City Coordinators and 592 Observers have been positioned.
- b) A third party audit of all examination centres has been completed.
- c) Live CCTV- As done for JEE (Main) Jan-2019 Examination, CCTV Surveillance will be done in all examination centres to curb malpractices in the examinations. The NTA has also made arrangements for live viewing of centre locations and recording of CCTVs Systems of all examination centres at the Control Room established in the NTA.
- d) A network of more than 4200 Test Practice Centres, especially for students of rural areas, has also run free practice sessions.
The Mock Tests are also available online. About 1.61 crore candidates have benefited Mock Test from using Online/Offline facility from 8th Sept 2018 till 5th April 2019.
- e) Jammers: In order to stop cheating using mobile networks, Jammers have been installed in all the Centres. A total of about 3,000 jammers per shift in all 10 shifts have been put in place.

While assuring the candidates of the highest professional conduct of the exam, NTA requests cooperation of all the stakeholders for an orderly conduct of the exam.
