# Sub.: Declaration of Joint Entrance Examination [JEE (Main) - 2024] Session 1 NTA Scores for Paper 2 (B.Arch. / B.Planning) – reg.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) conducted the Joint Entrance Examination (Main)—2024 Session 1 (January 2024) in about **421** Centres in **299** Cities (including **15 cities** outside India) as per the details given below for **Paper 2** (**B.Arch.** / **B.Planning**):

**Paper 2** of the JEE (Main) - 2024 Session 1 was conducted as per the following details:

- i. B. Arch. (Paper 2A): Mathematics-(Part I) and Aptitude Test-(Part II) in "Computer Based Test (CBT)" mode and Drawing Test –(Part III) in "Pen & Paper" (offline) mode.
- ii. B. Planning(Paper 2B): Mathematics-(Part I), Aptitude Test-(Part II), and Planning (Part III) in "Computer Based Test (CBT)" mode.

The Examination was held in 13 languages (Assamese, Bengali, English, Gujarati, Hindi, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu).

The Examination was also conducted in 15 cities outside India Manama, Colombo, Doha, Dubai, Kathmandu, Muscat, Riyadh, Sharjah, Singapore, Kuwait City, Kuala Lumpur, Lagos/Abuja, and Washington D.C. The examination was also conducted in Abu Dhabi and Oslo cities for the first time.

The examination for Paper 2A (B.Arch.) and Paper 2B (B.Planning) was conducted in one shift on 24 January 2024. The scores of Paper 2A (B.Arch.) and Paper 2B (B.Planning) are being declared today.

The Examination was monitored in the following ways:-

- A Central Control Room was opened to monitor and facilitate the smooth conduct of the Examination on the ground. 02 National Coordinators, 18 Regional Coordinators, 303 City Coordinators, 1083 Observers, 150 Technical Observers, and 162 Deputy Observers were deployed.
- Live CCTV Surveillance was planned in all examination centres to curb malpractices in the examination. The NTA also made arrangements for live viewing of remote locations of all examination centres from the Control Room located in the NTA premises of New Delhi. Recording of CCTV Systems was also done.
- The examination centres were also monitored using AI-based Video Analytics and Virtual Observers.
- In order to stop cheating using mobile networks, Jammers were installed in all the Centres to prevent unfair practices by the candidates during the examination through mobile or any other electronic device. **The latest 5GJammers** were installed at all examination Centres for the first

time.

The NTA took various steps to ensure candidates were facilitated at every stage of the examination. The first time, the following initiatives were taken by the NTA for the smooth conduct of the examination:

- AADHAAR Authentication was done at all examination Centres.
- ➤ A detailed training programme was organized to curb electronic malpractices during the examination. Accordingly, the Technical Observers were identified and trained to focus on technical parameters to prevent malpractices.
- ➤ If a candidate went for bio-break /toilet, he/she was asked to undergo the mandatory frisking and biometrics again.
- ➤ Bio-breaks were not allowed during the first hour and the last half an hour before the end of the test.
- Apart from the biometric attendance and frisking at entry, candidates were frisked, and biometric attendance was taken again on entry from the bio-break/toilets break.
- ➤ The PwD candidates were allotted to a PwD-friendly test Centre and extra organizational support was given to those candidates.
- For the centres outside India, close coordination was done with the Embassy of India / High Commission of India in those countries.

In order to make the examination system transparent, the Question Paper and recorded responses along with the Answer Key were displayed on the website for verification by examinees. After verification by the Subject Experts, the Revised Answer Keys were published on the website.

The JEE (Main) being one of the most sensitive examinations, NTA made elaborate arrangements at various levels and took help from State Authorities for the smooth conduct of the examination.

To make the candidates and their parents aware of the rules and regulations of the examination, candidates were sent various e-mails on their registered e-mail numbers. SMS was also sent to all the candidates to download "Important Advisory and Instructions to the candidates for JEE (Main) - 2024" along with the Admit Card.

NTA Scores are normalized scores across multi-session papers and are based on the relative performance of all thosewho appeared for the examination in one session. The marks obtained are converted into a scale ranging from 100 to 0 for each session of examinees.

The NTA Score of a Candidate has been calculated as follows:

100 X Number of candidates appeared in the 'Session' with raw score EQUAL TO OR LESS than the candidate

**NTA** score is not the same as the percentage of marks obtained.

The candidate's particulars including Category and Person with Disability (PwD) have been indicated as mentioned by the candidate in the online Application Form.

After both Sessions of the JEE (Main) - 2024 Examination for Paper 2, the ranks of the candidates will be released taking into consideration the best of the two NTA Scores in accordance with the policy already made.

The entire examination was conducted smoothly and successfully.
