**Subject: Release of Admit Cards for the Candidates of National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2026-reg.**

The National Testing Agency (NTA) is conducting the National Common Entrance Test (NCET)-2026 on 17 and 18 April, 2026 through the Computer Based Test (CBT) mode.


2. Admit cards for this exam have been released today i.e. 13 April, 2026. The candidates are required to download their Admit Card (using their Application No. and Password) from the website <https://exam.nta.nic.in/ncet/> and go through the instructions contained therein as well as in the Information Bulletin.

3. Candidates are advised to note the following:

- The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility conditions.
- Admit Card will not be sent by post.
- Candidate should not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of the admission process.
- Candidates are advised to preserve a copy of their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
