

CSIR-UGC NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY TEST (CSIR-UGC NET) DECEMBER, 2019

PUBLIC NOTICE (09 September, 2019)

The **National Testing Agency (NTA)** has been established by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) as an independent/autonomous, self-reliant and self-sustained premier testing organization. The conduct of the CSIR- UGC NET Examination has been entrusted to the NTA by CSIR, Government of India.

The NTA will conduct the next CSIR-UGC NET for **Junior Research Fellowship** and **eligibility for Lecturership (LS)/Assistant Professorship** on **15 December 2019** for following subjects.

1. Life Sciences
2. Physical Sciences
3. Chemical Sciences
4. Earth Sciences
5. Mathematical Sciences

The Test will be conducted in **two** different shifts as given below:

Shift	Timing	Duration
*Shift – 1 (Morning)	09:30 am to 12:30 pm (IST)	03 hours (180 Minutes)
*Shift – 2 (Afternoon)	02:30 pm to 05:30 pm (IST)	

**Subject(s) in a shift will be decided based on number of students.*

The Test will be conducted in **Computer Based Test (CBT)** mode only.

The candidates who desire to appear in the Test may see the details in the Information Bulletin for CSIR-UGC NET December 2019, which will be available on the website www.nta.ac.in and csirnet.nta.nic.in w.e.f. **09 September, 2019**.

The candidates are required to apply online during the period from **09 September 2019** to **09 October, 2019**. The Application Fees can be paid up to **10 October, 2019**.
