National Testing Agency is conducting the Joint Entrance Examination (Main) – 2023 Session 1 at different Centres located in 290 cities throughout the country and 18 Cities Outside India on 24, 25, 29, 30, 31 January and 1 February 2023 for B.E./B.Tech (Paper I) and 28 January (2<sup>nd</sup> Shift) for B.Arch and B.Planning (Paper 2A & Paper 2B). The candiates have already been intimated about their city and their date of exam as well as shift on 18.1.2023.

The candidates can download their Admit Cards from the website **jeemain.nta.nic.in w.e.f. 21.01.2023 (Saturday) for the first day of session 1 i.e 24 January (Tuesday)** The admit cards of candidates for  $25^{\text{th}}$  January i.e day 2 will be released tomorrow and for other dates will be released subsequently. Candidates are advised to download their Admit Card of Joint Entrance Examination (Main), 2023 Session 1 (using their Application No. and Date of Birth) along with the undertaking of JEE (Main) Session 1 - 2023 and go through the instructions contained therein.

Time mentioned in the Admit Card is Indian Standard Time(IST)
