The National Testing Agency conducted the National Forensic Admission Test (NFAT-2023) in Computer Based Test (CBT) Mode for about 11,787 Candidates who had opted for above 14 Courses at 26 Examination Centres located in 20 Cities across India as per above schedule.

Candidates were given an opportunity for raising Challenges from 12th July, 2023 to 14th July, 2023 along with the Provisional Answer Key, Question Paper and Recorded Responses. In this duration, about 305 Answer Key Challenges were received out of which 93 were Unique Challenges. These Provisional Answer Key Challenges were shown to the Subject Experts. Based on their feedback and after incorporating the changes, the Final Answer Keys were prepared which were used in preparing the Score of NFAT-2023.

The Role of NTA is confined to generation of Roll No. based on the data provided by NFSU, conduct of written test through CBT Mode, hosting of answer keys, inviting challenges, finalizing answer keys, preparing and handing over the Score to NFSU.
