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## Rules to be followed for the Online Proctored Exam are:

- 1. Candidates are expected to maintain the sanctity and integrity of the exam and not resort to any unfair means.
- 2. The Exam is remotely proctored. Candidates are advised to note that they will be under invigilation by Human Proctors during the exam, who will monitor their movements, including those on their screen.
- 3. At any point of time during the exam, if the Proctor finds any suspicious eye movements or any suspicious activities in the exam environment, candidate can be asked by the Proctor through Chat, to turn the Laptop/Webcam to show his/her surroundings. Warning on Chat shall appear on the candidate's console on suspicious behaviour. If the candidate does not follow the instructions even after repeated warnings from the Proctor, the exam can be terminated for the Candidate by the Proctor. Candidates are required to keep a check on the chat window for any communication from the Proctor.
- 4. Candidates are not allowed to keep any sheets of papers for noting down anything or for doing any rough work.
- 5. Candidates will be permitted to keep the following items with them during the exam:
  - i. Admit Card
  - ii. Valid ID proof
  - iii. Drinking water in a transparent water bottle.
