The subject of populism is currently often cited in debates on the prevalence of the classical vs. the modern interpretations. This may conjure up images of the Venezuelan President Hugo Chávez and his colourful speeches against the "Empire" of the United States of America and its allies. For other observers, populism is emblematic of the Argentinian Juan Domingo Perón and his wife, Evita, delivering speeches to the crowd of descamisados from the balcony of the Casa Rosada, the headquarters of the Argentinian government in the 1940s-1950s. Of course, there are many similarities between the events of the two eras, especially the high importance of an aggressive and authoritarian type of presidential discourse, which may create deep rifts in the society, dividing it into supporters vs. opponents. Implicitly, the social inequalities in the Latin American political life, with their potential for social polarization and instability, represent the structural background of these events. However, the differences between them are equally important and they cannot be reduced to the contexts of the two periods. These have led to different ways of approaching populism not from an analytical, but also from an axiological point of view, which is probably much more important for understanding this debate.
