In the center of the girls’ school was a courtyard where they played in total seclusion and safety from the outside world. Across all these years since childhood, I can still hear the shouts of girls playing games in that courtyard—shouts that we heard from our side of a broken wall we often toyed with the idea of climbing. Enclosed by a ring of classrooms, Ashok trees and the wall, the girls’ school was legally accessible through a twenty-foot high iron gate that was opened only twice a day—to let the girls in and to let them out. The boys’ school had no such courtyard or major entrance. Our playground was an annex, just a big space attached to the school, devoid of any symbolism of confinement. This architectural difference between boys’ and girls’ schools is an important aspect of our school culture and it has persisted to this day.”
