



When visual information is restricted to any degree, learning, problem-solving, orientation, memory systems, and even decision making may deteriorate temporarily as a result of adjusting to less sensory awareness and stimulus input. Individuals with visual impairment show variance in personality style, attribution style, locus of control, family support, interpersonal relationships, and financial availability. The dimension of effect will depend on the degree of disability and at the onset of impairment. If the loss is pre-lingual it has more significant effects on development - marred by experiences that leave them confused and angry. Loss of sight poses a number of problems in the individual and his family resulting in psychological distress in all people with visual impairment. According to Carroll (1991) visual impairment may affect functional independence and compromise psychological security not only in the individual with visual impairment, but in the family as well. Activities of daily living are disrupted. Communication skills are affected, impacting social functioning. They may be reluctant to attend social functions or go to crowded places for fear of embarrassment. Persons with sight loss may be afraid to leave home because of safe mobility issues. Transportation can be a problem. One could face job and financial insecurity or change in career plans. Visual impairment creates loss in aesthetic pleasure. There may be numerous changes in quality of life and changes in life goals that affect the visually impaired as well as the family.

Soft skills

The term "soft skills" is widely used, but scarcely defined. Conrad (1999) stated uncertainty of the precise origin of use of the term "soft skills". Early reference was discovered in military training documents from the early 1970s. Joubert et al. (2006): "There is no ultimate definition of soft skills, but they include such skills such as ethics, attitudes, interpersonal abilities, communication and being a lifelong learner".

Klaus (2007) states that soft skills encompass personal, social, communication and self-management skills. Examples mentioned are: self-awareness, trustworthiness, conscientiousness, adaptability, critical thinking, attitude, initiative, liability, influence, risk taking, problem solving, leadership and time management. Soft skills are those skills which are

used when one human interacts with another human. According to Simpson (2006), it is an ability or competence and can be either inherent or acquired which can be repeatedly performed.

Unfortunately, some young individuals with visual impairment will not have developed these important skills by the time they leave high school. Many of them experience difficulties as they shift from classroom to the workplace. For such individuals, who face higher unemployment rates than their sighted peers, soft skills are especially important and may need more focused attention to master. Some of them have specific disabilities that make it hard for them to control impulses. Others may have limited insight into themselves or difficulty getting along with others. They have varying amounts of exposure to the working world.

Some young people need to learn the importance of being at work on time, calling in when they are ill, and getting along with co-workers. For these reasons, it is vital that families and teachers help youth with visual impairment to develop soft skills. Research shows that soft skills can indeed be effectively learned. A comprehensive soft skills training curriculum provide visually impaired students with a strong conceptual and practical framework to build and develop necessary skills thereby enhancing their personal, educational and career prospects.
