The French Sociologist Gustavo Le Bon (1895) devoted a whole book to study the nature of crowds; he described how the people in a crowd often think, feel and act in extreme ways like mob scenes, crowd hysteria and how they accept or reject ideas uncritically. He contrasted the behaviour of people when they are alone with their behaviour when they are members of large groups. Though they are temporary and though they are without structure, crowds and audiences are of great significance in social life. The crowd is the most transitory and unstable of all social groups. It is an unorganized group. Crowds form quickly and also dissolve quickly as we can see in the market place. The crowds differs from the audience in that the participants in an assembly, public meeting or cinema house fall into the predetermined order and are arranged according to some principle of selection; but in a crowd there is no such order whatever.
