Sub: - NTA Declares the Result/NTA Scores of Ph.D. Entrance Test for DU, JNU, BHU and BBAU - 2023 – Reg.

The National Testing Agency has conducted Ph.D. Entrance Test for DU, JNU, BHU and BBAU 2023 in the Computer Based Test (CBT) mode on 26, 27, 30 and 31 October 2023. The test was planned for 50971 Candidates and 35896 had appeared.

- The medium of the Question Paper was English and Hindi except Sciences and Languages.
- Ph.D. Entrance Test for DU, JNU, BHU and BBAU 2023 examination was also conducted at 114 Centres in 86 Cities.
- NTA displayed the answer keys and recorded responses of candidates from 08 November
 2023 to 10 November 2023 and invited challenges through Public Notice.
- 320 Answer Key Challenges were received out of which 221 were the unique challenges.
- The challenges were placed before the concerned Subject Experts for review. Based on their feedback and after incorporating the changes, the Final Answer Keys were prepared which were used in preparing the Result of Ph.D. Entrance Test for DU, JNU, BHU and BBAU 2023.
- The Role of NTA is confined to the Registration of candidates, conduct of the test, hosting
 of Answer Keys, inviting challenges, finalizing Answer Keys, preparing and declaring
 results, and hosting Score Card

The Examination was monitored in the following ways:-

- A Central Control Room was opened to monitor and facilitate the smooth conduct of the Examination on the ground. **18** Zonal Coordinators, **10** Regional Coordinators, **86** City Coordinators and **127** Observers were deployed.
- All examination centres were under live CCTV Surveillance to curb malpractices in the examination. The NTA also made arrangements for live viewing of remote locations of all examination centres from the Control Room located in the NTA premises of New Delhi. Recording of CCTV Systems was also done.

- The examination centres were also monitored using AI-based Video Analytics and Virtual Observers.
- In order to stop cheating using mobile networks, Jammers were installed in all the Centres.
