Kind Attention to the Candidates of Silchar, Assam who will be appearing for the CUET (UG) - 2024 – reg.

The National Testing Agency is conducting the CUET (UG) – 2024 Examination in Hybrid mode (CBT and Pen & Paper) Mode on 15, 16, 17, 18, 21, 22, and 24 May 2024 at various Examination Centers located in 379 cities including 26 cities outside India, for about 13.48 lacs candidates.

Due to logistical constraints, some candidates were assigned their examination Centres outside Silchar for Bengali (104) and Environmental Studies (307) test papers to be conducted in CBT mode on 24 May 2024.

Based on their representation to change their examination Centre to Silchar only and to support the students' community, it has been decided that for those candidates who will not be able to reach their assigned Centres, their examination will be held as per the following details:

29 May 2024 (Wednesday)	Silchar, Assam	Bengali (104) and Environmental Studies (307)	Pen and Paper (OMR-based) mode.

Such candidates are advised **not to travel outside Silchar, Assam**. Fresh Admit Cards to the concerned candidates will be released soon on the official website of the CUET (UG) – 2024 i.e. https://exams.nta.ac.in/CUET-UG/

This opportunity is being provided to those candidates only who opted for Silchar as the examination Centre and have received an Admit Card for the CUET (UG) - 2024 for another City due to logistic reasons.

Also, those candidates who have already reached their examination City as mentioned in the available Admit Card may appear for the CBT mode examination on 24 May 2024.

All affected candidates are encouraged to take advantage of this opportunity to ensure they can appear for their exams.
