Subject: NTA Declares the Result / NTA Scores of National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2025 – reg.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) for admission to the 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) in selected Central/State Universities/Institutions including IITs, NITs, RIEs, and Government Colleges for the Academic Session 2025–26.

The NCET 2025 was conducted on 29 April 2025 in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode in 155 cities across the country and in 13 mediums in two shifts. A total of 54470 candidates registered for the examination, out of which 44927 candidates appeared.

The Question Papers were available in **13 languages**: *English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu*. This multilingual approach was designed to ensure that candidates from different regions could comfortably take the exam in their preferred medium.

Candidates were given the opportunity to view their responses and challenge the Provisional Answer Keys between **20 May and 22 May 2025**. A total of **191 challenges for 124 questions** (across **19 subjects**) were received and evaluated by expert panels. Based on their recommendations, answer key for **three questions** were updated in the Final Answer Keys, which were then used for result processing. The Final Answer Keys have been published on the official website: <u>https://exams.nta.ac.in/NCET</u> on **13 June 2025**. The results / NTA Scores for the NCET 2025 are being declared today i.e. **16 June 2025** (Monday). The candidates can view/download their Score Card by login using their Application Number and Date of Birth on the website: <u>https://exams.nta.ac.in/NCET</u>

The score data of all appeared candidates are being shared with the participating universities/institutions, which have been recognized by the NCTE to offer the 4-Year ITEP. For the academic session 2025–26, 77 such institutions (list available on the website: <u>https://exams.nta.ac.in/NCET</u>) across the country have been approved by the NCTE.

Candidates who have appeared in NCET 2025 will participate in the Counselling/Admission process of the Central/State University / Institution (IITs, NITs, RIEs, and Govt. Colleges etc.) as per list available on the NCET portal, which have been granted recognition by NCTE for ITEP for the academic session 2025-26. University/Institution/Govt. College etc. may fill up the vacant seats, thereafter, from the pool of NCET qualified candidates."

The role of NTA is confined to the registration of candidates, the conduct of the test, hosting answer keys, inviting challenges, finalizing answer keys, preparing and declaring results, hosting score cards, and handing over the score data to the participating Universities/ Institutions/ Government Colleges.

The Examination was monitored in the following ways:-

- The Central Control Room was opened to monitor and facilitate the smooth conduct of the Examination on the ground.
- 151 City Coordinators and approximately 537 Observers were positioned.
- Live CCTV Surveillance was planned in all examination centres to curb malpractices in the examination. The NTA also made arrangements for live viewing of remote locations of all examination centres from the Control Room located in the NTA premises of New Delhi. Recording of CCTV Systems was also done.
- The examination centres were also monitored using AI-based Video Analytics and Virtual Observers.
- In order to stop cheating using mobile networks, Jammers were installed in all the Centres.

The NCET 2025 provided access and flexibility in the following ways:

I. The exam was conducted in two shifts across 155 cities, and normalized percentile scores were issued using the standard NTA methodology to ensure fairness across sessions.











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II. NCET 2025 recorded a significant increase in attendance, reaching 82.51%, the highest in the three years of NCET's conduct. This reflects improved outreach, better candidate preparation, and growing interest in the ITEP programme.

- *III.* In total, 66 subjects (38 languages, 27 Domain-Specific Subjects, and One General Test) were offered for the candidates in the NCET 2025.
- *IV.* An overall choice in all subjects was given. In languages and Teaching Aptitude, candidates had to attempt any 20 questions out of 23, and for domainspecific subjects and the General Test, 25 questions out of 28 questions were to be attempted.
- *V. Grievances of individual students based on their experience in NCET 2025 were considered.*
- *VI.* For the preparation of Question papers, about 640 subject Experts and 332 translators were involved in the massive exercise of preparing the Question Papers for the NCET 2025.
