Subject: Release of Admit Card for National Teachers Eligibility Test (NTET)-2025.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will conduct National Teachers Eligibility Test (NTET) - 2025 for Postgraduates of Indian Systems Medicine and Homoeopathy who desire to take up teaching profession on 17 July, 2025 in Computer-Based Test (CBT) Mode.

2. Admit Card of the candidates are made live today, i.e. **12 July 2025** and hosted on <u>https://exams.nta.ac.in/NTET/.</u>

3. Candidates can download their Admit Card from the above mentioned website using their Application Number and Date of Birth. Candidates are also advised to read the instructions contained therein carefully.

- 4. Candidates are advised to note the following:
 - The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility conditions.
 - Admit Card will not be sent by post.
 - Candidate must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
 - Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of the admission process.
 - Candidates are advised to preserve a copy of their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
