The National Testing Agency will conduct the Entrance Examinations for **UG and PG Programmes (Regular and NLEA)** for **NIFT Admissions – 2026** in around **129** centres located in **97** Cities in **Hindi and English** mediums across India in Computer Based Test (CBT) / Paper Based Test (PBT) mode on **8 February 2026 (Sunday)** for Academic Session 2026-27 **for the following Programmes:**

- **Bachelor of Design (B.Des.),**
- **Bachelor of Fashion Technology (B.F.Tech.),**
- **Master of Design (M.Des.),**
- **Master of Fashion Management (M.F.M.),**
- **Master of Fashion Technology (M.F.Tech.)**
- **NIFT Lateral Entry Admission (NLEA)- B.Des. and B.F.Tech.**

We hope that you have downloaded the Admit Card and are now fully prepared to appear for the **NIFTEE-2026** Examination on the **date, shift, Course, and venue of the Test Centre as indicated on the Admit Card** downloaded from the NTA website i.e. <https://exams.nta.nic.in/niftee/>.

No Candidate should adopt any unfair means or indulge in any unfair examination practices as the examination centres are under surveillance of CCTV and equipped with Jammers.

Kindly keep in mind the following:

1. AADHAAR verification:

- **Candidates are advised to bring their AADHAAR Card as verification of the candidates will be carried out through the AADHAAR authentication process.**
- Initially, Biometrics will be done by taking the thumb impression of the candidate multiple times. For any candidate, whose thumb impressions will not match, then Biometrics will be carried out through the iris.
- If any candidate does not carry an AADHAAR card, his/her verification will be carried out by other means. This will be recorded in the Exception Form.

2. Please download your Admit Card from the NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/niftee/> only.

3. Please check the Reporting Time at Centre, Gate Closing time of Centre, Date of Examination, Shift and Timings of Test, Venue of Test following as indicated on the Admit Card.



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4. You should visit the Examination Centre, in advance and familiarize yourself with the location and means of reaching the venue of the Test on time.
5. On the day of the Examination, please reach the venue of the Test at the **Reporting Time** mentioned in the Admit Card. If you report beyond the **Gate Closing time of the Centre**, you will not be allowed to enter the Test venue. Instructions have been issued for strict compliance. Several pre-examination formalities need to be completed and therefore please arrive on time.
6. **You should carry with you only the following items:**
 - Personal transparent water bottle,
 - Admit Card along with Self Declaration (Undertaking) downloaded from the NTA website (a clear printout on A4 size paper) duly filled in.
 - Additional passport-size photograph for pasting on the Attendance Sheet
 - Original valid ID proof
 - A simple transparent Ball Point Pen/ Pencil / Erasers / Ruler (In a transparent pouch)/ A-4 Transparent Acrylic Board (for B.Des./M.Des. candidates).
7. Before reaching the Centre, candidates must enter the required details, paste the Photograph, and put a thumb impression at the appropriate place on the Admit Card. They should ensure that their Left-Hand Thumb Impression is clear and not smudged.
8. **Candidates appearing for both Bachelor of Design (B. Des) and Master of Design (M. Des.) programmes are required to bring two sets of Admit Cards to their respective examination centers.**

9. MARKING SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

For Multiple Choice Questions: To answer a question, the candidates need to choose one option corresponding to the correct answer or the most appropriate answer. However, if any anomaly or discrepancy is found after the process of challenges of the key verification, it shall be addressed in the following manner:

- i. *Each question carries 01 (One) mark.*
- ii. *For each correct response, the candidate will get 01 (One) mark.*
- iii. *For each incorrect response, -0.25 mark will be deducted from the total score.*
- iv. *Un-answered/un-attempted will be given no marks.*
- v. *To answer a question, the candidate needs to choose one option as the correct option.*
- vi. *However, after the process of Challenges of the Answer Key, in case there are multiple correct options or change in key, only those candidates who have attempted it correctly as per the revised Answer key will be awarded marks.*
- vii. *In case a Question is dropped due to some technical error, full marks shall be given to all the candidates irrespective of the fact who have attempted it or not.*

10. Candidate must carry “Any one of the original and valid Photo Identification Proof issued by the Government” – PAN card/Driving License/Voter ID/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/ E-Aadhaar/ Ration Card/ Aadhaar Enrolment No. With Photo. All other



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IDs/Photocopies of IDs even if attested/scanned photo of IDs in the mobile phone will NOT be considered valid ID Proof.

- **PwD certificate** issued by the Competent Authority, if claiming the relaxation under the PwD category. Candidates with Physical Disability are requested to report early for facilitation during entry.
- A PwD candidate (having a physical limitation to write) *who will be availing the facility of Scribe* will be allowed Compensatory/ Extra time of 20 minutes per hour of the examination, whether such candidate uses the facility of Scribe or not.
- The facility of the Scribe, in case he/she has a physical limitation and a scribe is essential to write the examination on his/her behalf, being so certified in the prescribed format by a CMO/Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution.
- **Facilities to provide the Scribe for PwD candidates cannot be provided in the Creative Ability Test (CAT).**
- The facility of Scribe will be provided to the PwD candidates only if he has opted for the same in the online Application Form of NIFTEE-2026.
- The candidate will have the **discretion of opting for his own Scribe or to avail the facility of Scribe provided by the NTA**. Appropriate choice in this regard has been given by the candidate in the online Application Form.

11. Candidates are NOT allowed to carry any other personal belongings including electronic devices, or mobile phones to the Examination Centre. Examination Officials will not be responsible for the safekeeping of personal belongings and there will be no facility.
12. **Blank paper sheets for rough work** will be provided in the examination Hall/Room. Candidates must write their name and Roll Number at the top of each of the sheet(s) and must hand over the sheet/s to the invigilator without fail, before leaving the Examination Hall/Room. Failure to do so may result in a non-evaluation of your answers.
13. No Candidate should adopt any unfair means or indulge in any unfair examination practices. All the Examination Centres are under surveillance of CCTV and equipped with Jammers. Any unfair practice including passing of chits will be dealt with punitive stringent action including debarment in future exams of NTA.
14. The candidate should ensure that the Question Paper available on the computer screen is as per his/her opted subject/medium indicated in the Admit Card. In case, the subject/medium of the Question Paper is other than his/her opted subject/medium, the same may be brought to the notice of the Invigilator concerned.
15. **The candidates are advised to carefully read the Subject-Specific Instructions and other instructions mentioned in the Question paper and abide by the same.**



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16. If at any stage, it is found that the candidate has submitted multiple applications, his/her candidature will be cancelled and legal action will be taken including debarring in all future examinations conducted by NTA.

2. The GAT Paper will be **Bilingual i.e. Hindi and English**. Candidates are required to answer in the medium as per option exercised in the online Application Form (*if chosen*). In case of any ambiguity between Hindi and English version due to translation, English version would be treated as final.
3. Each question has **four** options. Candidates need to select one of the options, as answer of each question.
4. Use of calculator is NOT permitted.
5. Rough work has to be done only on the sheets provided to you at the centre. You should write your roll number and name on them, before using them. You should drop them in the drop box while leaving. Failure to drop them would be treated as an act of unfair means.
6. You are not allowed to carry Mobile Phones or any other Electronic Device inside the exam Lab.
7. Candidates found copying or resorting to any unfair means (UFM) are liable to be disqualified from this and future examinations conducted by NTA.

f. You can click on when you want to change the status and freeze the answer already given or answer the question.
