Subject: Advisory for completion of application process of UGC-NET June 2026 exam-reg.

The registration portal for the UGC-NET June 2026 examination shall be closing on 20 May 2026 (up to 11:50 PM).

All candidates who have not yet completed the process are once again advised to ensure that they:

- Fill and submit the online application form paying the prescribed examination fee.
- Download and retain the confirmation page for future reference.
- The detailed registration procedure is provided at **Annexure-I**.

Candidates are advised to check all the details filled in the online Application Form carefully before making the fee payment as no change shall be permitted later. Attention may be given to details such as Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name, Social Category, PwD Status, Difficulty in Writing Status, Scribe Requirement Status, Subject opted, and Exam City Choices selected by the candidate. Candidates should ensure that all information is correct and complete before final submission of the Application Form.

It is reiterated that only candidates who have successfully paid the fee will be considered as having completed the application process.

Annexure-I

Procedure

4.1 Accessing the Portal

- Step 1: Open the official UGC NET registration website.
- Step 2: Click on the "Register / New Registration" option on the homepage.
- Step 3: Read all instructions and guidelines displayed carefully.
- Step 4: Select the declaration checkbox to accept instructions.
- Step 5: Click "Click Here to Proceed". The system will redirect to DigiLocker authentication.

4.2 DigiLocker Registration (New Users)

- Step 6: Click "Sign Up".
- Step 7: Enter mobile number and complete OTP verification.
- Step 8: Select Identity Type (Aadhaar / PAN / Driving License).
Note: Registration is not Aadhaar-dependent. You may use any available identity option.
- Step 9: Fill in details: Name, DOB, Gender, Username, and PIN.
- Step 10: Click "Verify" and proceed to the authorization page.

4.3 DigiLocker Login (Existing Users)

- Step 11: Sign in using Mobile Number, PAN, or Driving License.
- Step 12: Enter the OTP received on your registered mobile number and click "Verify".

4.4 Consent and Form Submission

- Step 13: On the authorization page, click "Allow" or "Authorize" to share details with the portal.
- Step 14: Upon successful validation, the UGC-NET registration form will open automatically.
- Step 15: Fill in Personal, Contact, and educational details, set Security Questions, and enter CAPTCHA.
- Step 16: Review and click "Submit". The system will generate your Application Number.
